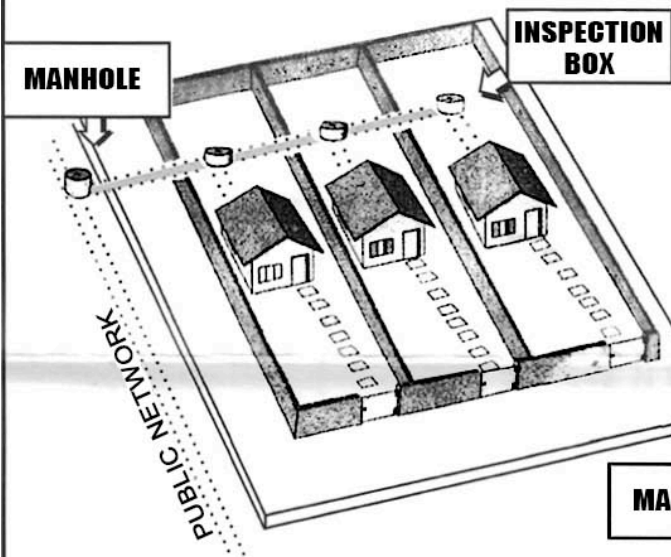




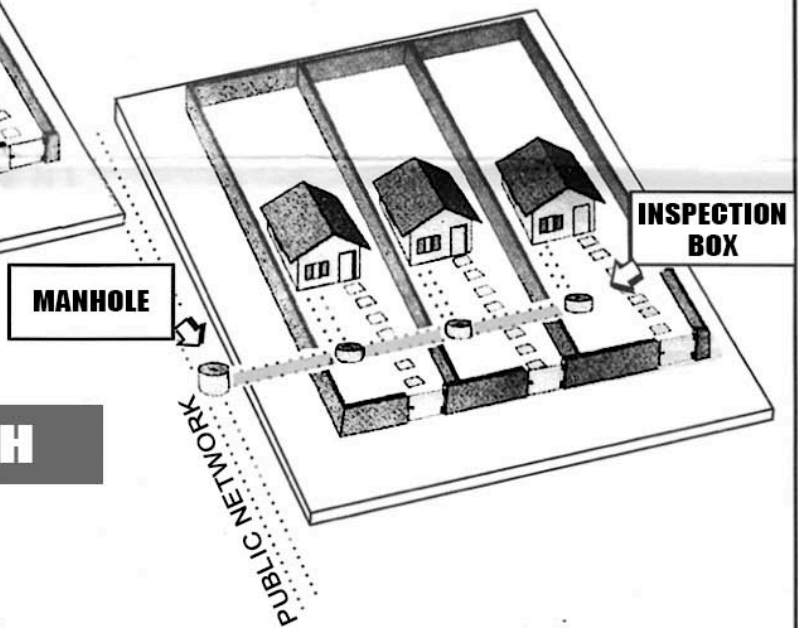
Condominial Sewerage System

As you know, there are three possible alternative sewerage lines that can be used to connect your household. The best alternative is determined with technical studies in collaboration with the residents.

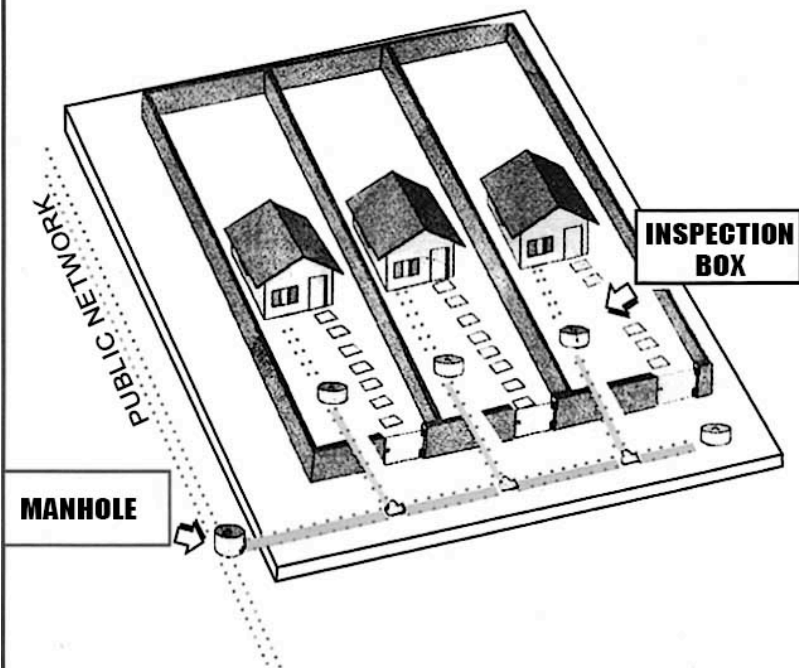
BACK YARD BRANCH

SIDEWALK BRANCH

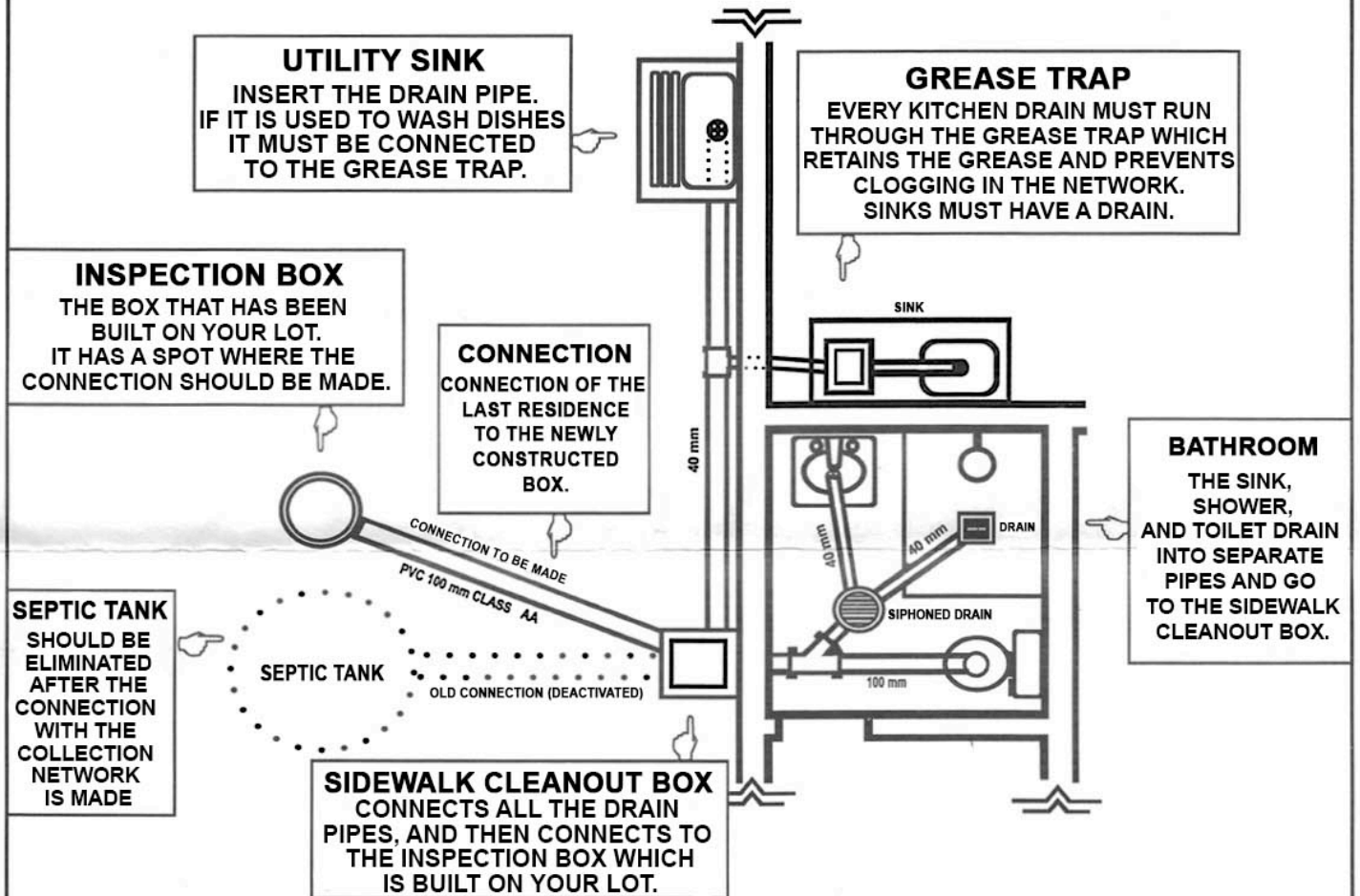


Caesb builds the public network, the branches, and an inspection box for each lot. The residents are responsible for the connection of their own household facilities (bath, sink, tank, etc.) until the inspection box is built.

SEWERAGE SYSTEM

YOU SHOULD NOW CONNECT YOUR HOUSEHOLD'S FACILITIES TO THE SEWER BOX THAT HAS BEEN BUILT ON YOUR LOT.

SHOWN BELOW IS A BASIC CONNECTION PLAN:

THE SEWER IS NOT FOR TRASH.

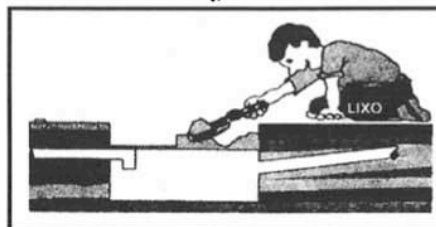
Paper, plastic, and food waste should go to the garbage

A GREASE TRAP IS MANDATORY.

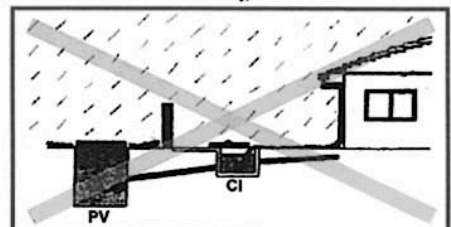
Do not forget to use it and clean it periodically
